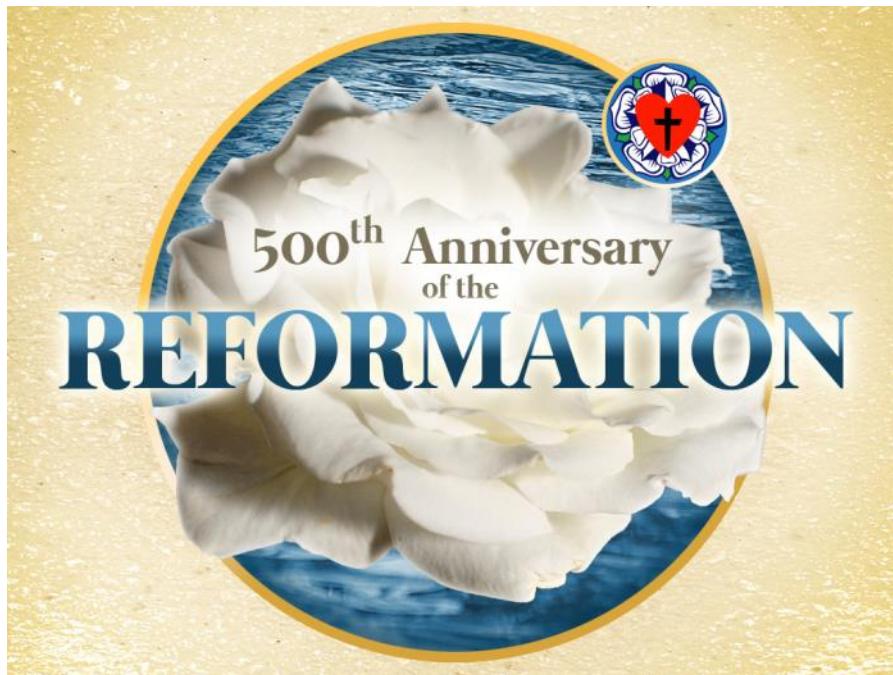




# ST. MATTHEW BROADCASTER
